Who can access Careway?


You may be suitable for the Careway programme if you have a knee, shoulder or spine injury that cannot be successfully treated solely by your general practitioner (GP). Your orthopaedic surgeon or physio will make an assessment to decide whether you should be on the Careway programme.

What services are provided?

A range of healthcare services are available to help you get better, faster including:

- Orthopaedic Surgeons
- Physiotherapists
- Sports Physicians
- Pain Management Specialists
- Vocational Therapists

What can I expect?

A dedicated team will work with you to set goals and to design a care plan that meets your needs. The team may include one or more of the services in the programme such as a physiotherapist, orthopaedic surgeon and/or sports physician.
